

They were nationally ranked pairs figure skaters for the United States (1986-1990), and their professional career included principal roles with the Ice Capades, Disney on Ice, and Stars on Ice, just to name a few. From 1998-2005, Jeb & Jennifer were the lead ice skaters at Radio City Music Hall (New York City) in The Christmas Spectacular starring the world-famous Radio City Rockettes. While still performing, Jeb began writing and directing shows. Since 1998, Jeb has created, produced and/or directed dozens of ice and non-ice show productions around the world, including star-studded television specials, such as Christmas on Ice in Torino, Italy starring Andrea Bocelli and Olympic Champion, Evgeny Plushenko, The Opening of the Rink at Rockefeller Center, and The Golden Skate Awards, which annually honors the top ranked figure skaters around the world. Additionally, Jeb has created holiday content for CBS, produced for ABC's Extreme Makeover and Masters of Champions. Fox's Louis Guzman Show, MTV's Music Awards, Dolly Parton's Dixie Stampede and Smokey Mountain Adventure, as well as numerous cable and regional television specials.
